This hands-on lab will cover basic needle and suture types utilized in veterinary surgery. We will discuss the pros and cons of each type and discuss scenarios for appropriate use. We will then quench your thirst (it is a dry lab after all) by practicing basic knot tying and suture patterns with inanimate models. CORRAL Volunteer Event



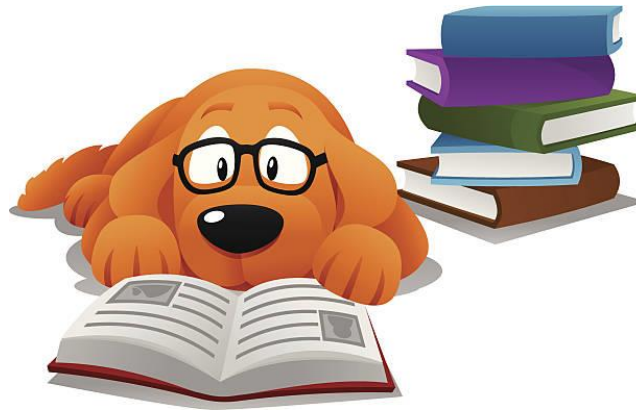

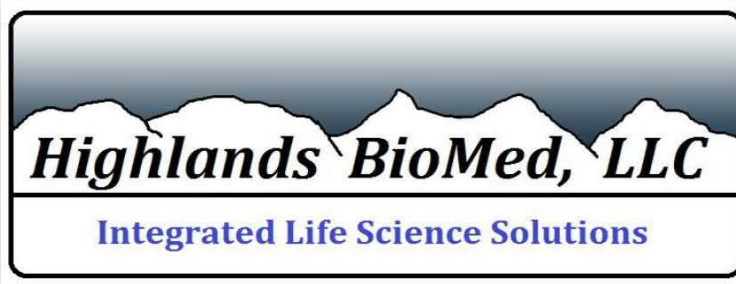

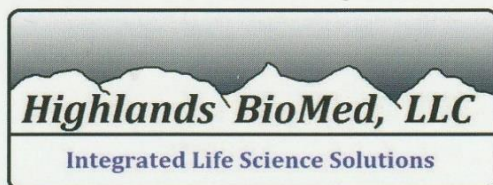
